
Technical Quiz


resource person was delivered by the Head of the Department, Dr. Naveen Kumar Sharma.

She also explain that in the planning also have to do proper market survey to see whether our product may match with any of the market existing product in such case we will we requiring to take various precautions properly verify that our company name or logo should not match with any other company. She also make the participants aware about that if we are going to start any such startups which may also have some effects on the environment or may have some effects on the health of the humans in such case various permission must be mandatory from the departments like Health department, narcotics department and other related departments as well besides these also other required formalities also we need to complete to make our startup future safe.

She also told that we also have to do required number of registrations like GST registration, company registration etc. she also disclosed that by doing proper planning and required permission, licenses and other formalities the startups will also be benefited by the various Government Schemes which are launched by the Government time to time. We all are also aware about the Make in India Scheme of the Government, it also provide the funding support to the viable startups to make them successful.

The session was very interacting between the participants and the resource persons. Many students and faculties asked related questions from the speaker to clear their doubts regarding the legal and ethical steps proper preparations and Ms.
